Financial Assistance Process

Financial Assistance is available to families who would not be able to send their children to Shorewood unless assistance is provided.

Financial Assistance Request Applications are now handled through FACTS, our tuition management company, which processes, reviews, and determines qualification and need for all families who apply.

Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary documentation to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment. Applicants can apply online only beginning the month of February via <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. A \$30 non-refundable fee is charged for the application. Once the application is complete, the payment will be required prior to submission.

All new family applications will be given an account number in order to complete the application. Current families already have an account number.

As part of the online application, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS:

- Copies of your most recent W-2 forms for both you and your spouse
- Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules, such as Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation and TANF.

All supporting documentation can be uploaded in PDF format online.

If you have questions or concerns about the application process, you may speak with a FACTS Customer Care Representative at 1-866-441-4637.

Once the application is completed FACTS will determine a recommended assistance amount. The school board will then review the recommendation and distribute assistance based on the need and the available funds within the school budget. Once this final determination has been made you will be contacted.

The financial assistance process may take up to a couple of months before you are contacted. In order to secure your child's placement at SCS you must fill out all registration forms and pay the registration fee.
